

# DO HAZ WASTE RIGHT!!


ALL JOURNEYS BEGIN WITH A SINGLE STEP - Fill out all appropriate information on the new waste label at the time the first drop of waste is added to the container.

GOOD TO THE LAST DROP - When the waste container is about 90% full, arrange for pickup and fill in the date when full. Must be picked up in three business days.

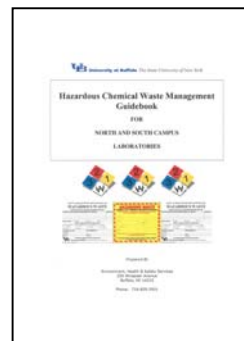
OPPOSITES ATTRACT! Or they GO BOOM! Separate incompatible chemicals, such as nitric acid and butanol (oxidizer and organic).
